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Materials

1 (1) skein of Sultan Deluxe col 19 – enough for 2 ponchos in the smallest size

Circular needle US 2.5 (3 mm), 15.7" (40 cm), 23.6" (60 cm) and 31.5" (80 cm)

Yarn quality

Sultan Deluxe, Cotton Kings
100 % Cotton/ 8.8 oz (250 g) = 1093
yds (1000 m)

Gauge 24 sts in pattern = 4" (10 cm)

Sizes 4-6 (8-10) years

Measurements

Neckline: Approx 18.1" (19.7") / 46 (50) cm Length to elbow: approx 14.6" (16.5") / 37 (42) cm

About the pattern

The poncho is worked top down.

The marked stitches at the increases must be placed directly above each other. Use a thread and place new markers during the work.

Change to circular needle 23.6" (60 cm) and 31.5" (80 cm) as the number of stitches increases.

Abbreviations for the increases

Make 1 knitwise through the back loop (M1 k tbl): Pick up the bar between the 2 stitches and knit it through the back loop. Make 1 purlwise through the back loop (M1 p tbl): Pick up the bar between the 2 stitches and purl it through the back loop. Make 1 purlwise through the front and back loop (M1 p fb): Work the yarn over (yo) through the front and the back loop like this: Purl 1, knit 1 through the back loop (p1, k1 tbl).

Make 1 knitwise through the front and back loop (M1 k fb): Work the yarn over (yo) through the front and the back loop like this: Knit 1, purl 1 through the back loop (k1, p1 tbl).

Neckline

Co 112 (120) sts with circular needle US 2.5 (3 mm), 15.7" (40 cm) and work garter stitch in the round like this: Rnd 1: Knit all sts. Rnd 2: Purl all sts. Repeat these two rnds until you have 3 furrows.

Place markers midway on the front and midway on the back

K 27 (29) sts, place markers around the next st = midway on the front, k 55 (59) sts, place markers around the next st = midway on the back, k the remaining sts on the rnd.

Pattern and increases

Rnd 1: K until marker, M1 k tbl, k the marked st, M1 k tbl, k until marker, M1 k tbl, k the marked st, M1 k tbl, k the remaining sts on the rnd.

Rnd 2: Knit all sts.

Rnd 3: K until marker, M1 k tbl, k the marked st, M1 k tbl, k until marker, M1 k tbl, k the marked st, M1 k tbl, k the remaining sts on the rnd.

Rnd 4: Knit all sts.

Rnd 5: P until marker, M1 p tbl, k the marked st, M1 p tbl, p until marker, M1 p tbl, k the marked st, M1 p tbl, p the remaining sts on the rnd.

Rnd 6: Repeat *yo, k2 tog* throughout the rnd.

Rnd 7: P until yo before marker, M1 p fb, k the marked st, M1 k fb, p until yo before marker, M1 p fb, k the marked st, M1 k fb, p the remaining sts on the rnd.

Rnd 8: Knit all sts.

Rnd 9: K until marker, M1 k tbl, k the marked st, M1 k tbl, k until marker, M1 k tbl, k the marked st, M1 k tbl, k the remaining sts on the rnd.

Rnd 10: Knit all sts.



Repeat these 10 rnds until the work measures approx 13.8" (15.7") / 35 (40) cm to the elbow = from the beginning of the rnd to the edge. End with 3-4 rnds of stockinette stitch.

Edge

Work garter stitch until you have 3 furrows. Bo.
